How to Achieve an Artistic Performance in this song?

1) Your Role in performing this song is... The Actor

Scenario: A close and personal conversation with a dear friend.
Perhaps, make the audience that special friend.

Use the Director as the Focal Point...

You are in Actor Mode: Make the director the person to whom you are expressing.

2) Identify the emotions, visualizations, and physical movement that is being referenced in this song,
3) Use your "expressers" to create the below referenced experiences and reactions in the audience.

Emotions: Love for life, and love for people
Let the changes in your vocal tone and inflection communicate these emotions.

Mood: Heartfelt, sincere, warmly reflective

Visual: Use your eyes and facial expression to describe the numerous visual references in the song.
Your goal is to get the audience to recall and visualize the special people and events of their life

Physical: Allow the body to move to the emotions of the lyrics, and the dynamics of the music.

Overall: This is a loving and sincere observation and reflection of life, the world, and it's people.
Create a sense of connection and community - "We are all in this together".
